## From the Pastor

I hope you are having a great summer. I have enjoyed this warm and hot weather, because sooner or later we will realize that we are in the Christmas season with snow and cold temperatures. We need to remember that before we know it, time flies fast.

The first week of July, our family joined the North Central Jurisdiction Korean American UMC Pastors and Family Retreat. I had to be there, for I had been part of the leadership team. The retreat was held in Rapid City, South Dakota. It took 13 hours to drive there. We went through Wisconsin, Minnesota, and South Dakota. It was pleasant to see the distinctiveness of each state. We stayed at the Storm Mountain Retreat Center which belongs to the Dakota Annual Conference. The Center was a perfect place to be apart. Once I got there, I felt an awe and wonder for the surrounding nature. During the retreat, we had worship, praise, prayers, lectures, fellowship, and tours. We also enjoyed sightseeing such as Mount Rushmore, Sylvan Lake, the Needles Highway, Badland National Park, and the Black Hills. Through the retreat, I felt we took a deep rest in nature that God has created and revealed.

There are two things I found from the recent trip in South Dakota: The first is that the South Dakota economy is heavily based on tourism. The people living there pursue visitors aggressively and lure many people to gambling places. Wherever I went, I could see gambling signs. It seemed to me that tourism would be risky for the people who live in South Dakota, because they sell Dakota to tourists. For this reason, their life might be in danger. The second thing I realized is that Indian reservations are the poorest and most invisible places in the nation. And their culture is being destroyed. But people keep selling their symbols and word in the name of Native American culture. How ironic that is! Anyway, in a nutshell, South Dakota is very different from Illinois, but I love their disparities.

This summer, our trustees have worked hard for our church. They were busy in order to set up the gate and railing. I really appreciate their efforts. When you meet one of our trustee members, please thank them. As you may know, we have been praying for paving the parking lot for a long time. As you can see, our parking lot needs to be fixed. Thankfully, Dick & Sharon Delawder graciously donated funds for this project. I am so grateful for their generosity. From the bottom of my heart, I would like to gratefully thank Dick & Sharon for their love for the church. Without each one of us, the church cannot exist, for we are the hands and feet of Jesus Christ. Let us continue to do the work that Jesus entrusts to us so that the church will thrive because of our commitment to Christ who is the head of the church.

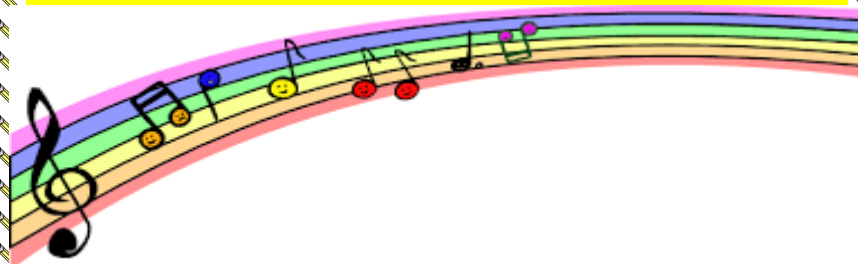
