From the Pastor

How is your summer going? Surely, we have been waiting for this beautiful weather. Now suddenly summer has come to us. I pray that all of us have a great summer.

Several weeks ago, as you may remember, I heard the news that Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris was burned. Almost every news channel as well as the newspapers covered that event. Personally, I've never been there, so I started to wonder why people were so focused on the fire at the Cathedral. At the same time as this incident, there were other fires in Louisiana where three black churches (St. Mary Baptist Church, Greater Union Baptist Church, and Mount Pleasant Baptist Church) were also burned. Interestingly enough, these churches did not draw much attention in the main media. Although most people, including me, would not travel to Paris, our eyes still looked to the fire at Notre Dame. Some people would love to contribute to rebuild the Cathedral. However, no one seemed to be interested in the black churches that had lost their buildings due to fire. I felt something was wrong. It was unfair. We have been taught that the church must be one body. It means when one of our parts hurts, we all hurt. For this reason, we need to grieve with our black brothers and sisters in Christ just as Jesus is concerned for the least, the lost, and the last.

This may lead us to focus our gaze to where Jesus invites us to look and realize that marginality is not far away from us. As Jesus commanded us, let us be attentive to those in need this summer.

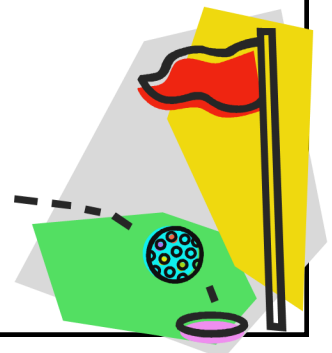

TRUSTEES CORNER

The Board of Trustees has secured bids for two projects which will improve safety at Good Samaritan.

***First, the installation of a handrail along the north side of the sidewalk up to Door#4, the main entrance. The hand rail will help those persons who need assistance while walking up or down this sidewalk.

***Second, a gate to close off the entrance at the northeast corner of our parking lot. When closed this gate will prevent unauthorized drivers from using our driveway and parking lot as a short cut between Army Trail Blvd. and the residential area to our north & east.

The gate will improve the safety of the students of the Sunrise Montessori school when they are outdoors. This gate will be opened to provide access for Sunday morning worship and during other church sponsored events.

The Endowment Committee has Agreed to let the Trustees borrow \$9,000.00 from the Endowment Fund to pay for these improvements.

We are in the process of preparing information to submit to the Village so we can get a building permit for these improvements.

We will be setting up a Fund Raising Campaign to collect money to repay the loan from the Endowment Fund.
