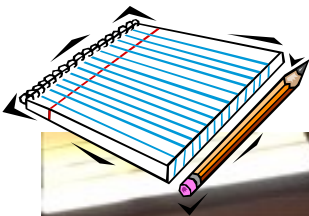

The handrail along the sidewalk up to Door#4 has been installed. The areas around the posts have been backfilled and the grass seed has sprouted. Everyone likes it!

Our Gate has been placed in service. A key for our lock on this gate has been provided to our snow plowing service.

We are conducting a fund raising campaign to repay our loan from the Endowment Fund. These funds were used to pay for the Handrail and Gate. After about 3 weeks we have received approximately \$6,600, which is over 70% of our goal of \$9,000.

Last month we cut back many of our bushes. We also removed several dead branches from trees around the parsonage and playground.

As 2019 comes to a close the Trustees wish to **THANK** those members who have participated in our various Work Days or cleanup activities, both inside and outside our Church. Many hands make light work!
