Covid-19 is still forcing us to stay home, even though Easter and the warmth of spring have come to us. When we go to buy essentials, we follow guidelines and put on masks and observe the distance of at least 6 feet. Given this situation and as time passes by, we've come to realize that human relations play a crucial role in our lives. It is almost impossible for us to live without love and social connections. We as humans are created to be in relationship with one another. When we lose connections and contact with each other, we easily fall into loneliness which could bring life risks.

As you may remember, when we coped with the 9/11 crisis, our relationship was stronger than ever before. In that situation, people did not want to be alone. We were eager to be united as one. We loved to gather and huddle our shoulders together to overcome the crisis. We came to church sanctuaries and prayed together before God. But Covid-19 makes us respond totally differently from our response in the aftermath of 9/11. Now we are asked to keep social distance and stay at home. These guidelines separate us from others. It means we cannot gather together in this crisis situation. Actually, in order to get over this pandemic, we should be able to gather together. That would be really helpful for all of us. But now we can't rely on the presence and personal help of one another. That is why this crisis is much harder than other times. This Covid-19 crisis is causing us deep suffering such as loneliness, fear, and an uncertain future. This reality leads us to feel helpless with the support of one another.

In this time I want all of us to remember Martin Rinkart (1586-1649), who was a German Lutheran clergyman and wrote the lyrics of the hymn "Now Thank We All our God." (The United Methodist Hymnal #102). The first verse starts: "Now thank we all our God, with heart and hands and voices; Who wondrous things has done, In whom this world rejoices." History tells us that Rinkart lived during the Thirty Years War and thereby experienced the death of 8,000 people who died of disease. Given that, many people, including other clergy, most of the town council members, and even his wife, died. Sometimes he was in charge of 200 funeral services in a week. In this tough time, he relied on God alone. It is amazing for us to see his faith in verse 2, "Keep us still in grace, And guide us when perplexed, And free us from all ills, in this world and the next." In a desperate situation, he found hope in an eternal God who had the power to keep Rinkart going for the work of people who needed grace.

Like him, with God's grace, we will get through this Covid-19 pandemic. I believe God has the power to restore all our relationships. Given God's grace, we will once more shake hands and hug each other with a great joy. We will feel liberated from the oppression of the virus. We will thank God for our face to face personal relationships.

Please stay healthy and be well until we once more come to worship God together in our sanctuary.


