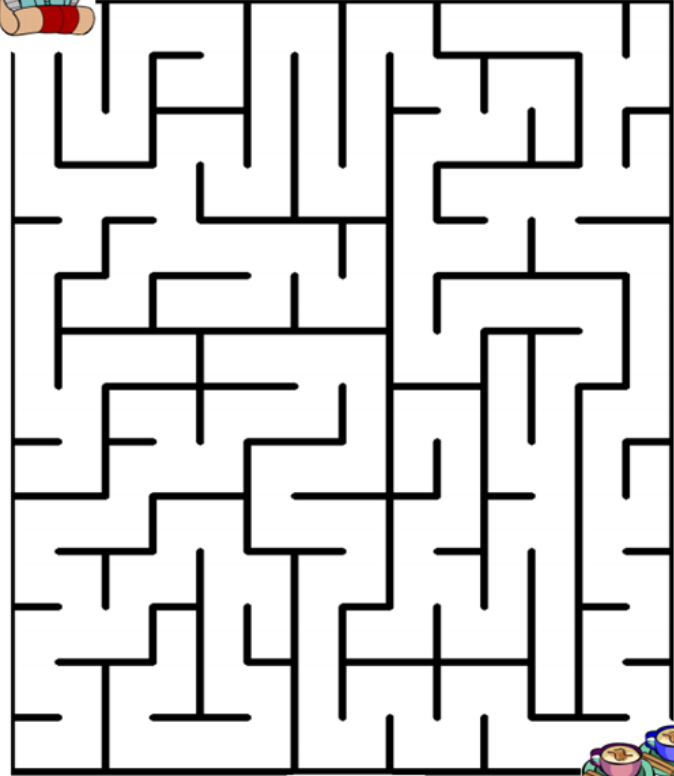

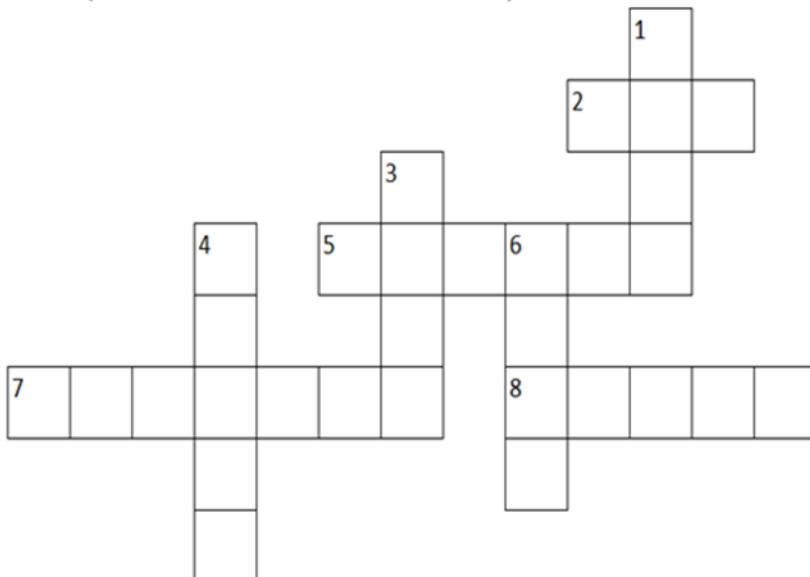

Epiphany is a Christian feast day that celebrates the revelation of God incarnate as Jesus Christ.

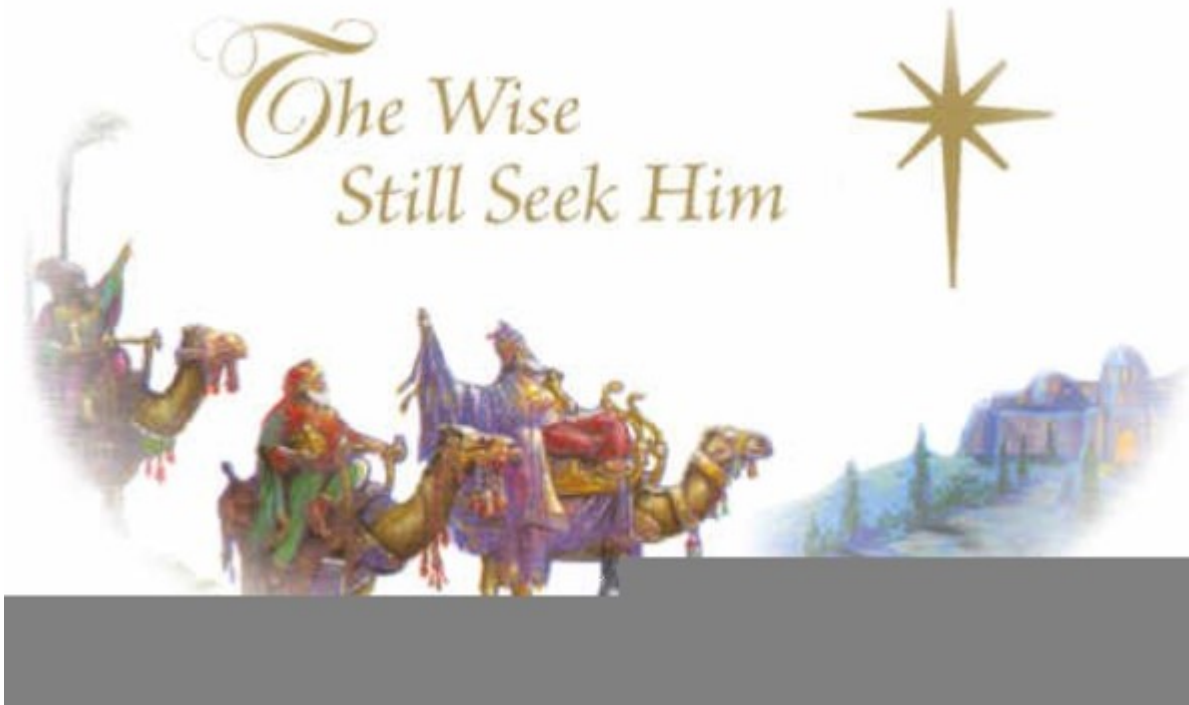
The first Sunday of January, the 3rd, we will have drive through communion following our face book live worship service at 10 A M- communion will be right after the service and served until 11:30.
