From the Pastor

Greetings in the name of our resurrected Jesus Christ!

Easter continues in this season of spring in which we feel new life through the beauty of nature. We are in the season of Easter. No person or no possession can take away our joy in Christ. We are safe in him. But we need to grow until perfection, as John Wesley encouraged us two centuries ago.

Since April 21, a Pastor’s Bible Study class has been offered, using the book, *Scripture and the Wesleyan Way: A Bible Study on Real Christianity* written by Scott J. Jones and Arthur D. Jones. Scott Jones is the resident Bishop of the Texas Annual Conference, and Arthur, Scott’s son, is a local pastor at St. Andrew United Methodist Church, Plano, Texas. In the book, the authors raise spiritual questions from our contemporary world and look at how the Bible teaches us concerning those questions, as well as getting answers from John Wesley, especially from the Wesleyan Way of Salvation. For this reason, we read a sermon of Wesley in each session. His sermons written in the 1700’s are not easy to read, but it is a worthwhile objective to try. In April, we dealt with two sermons: “The Way to the Kingdom” and “The Scripture Way of Salvation.” This is a good chance for us to study John Wesley’s theology through his sermons and the textbook used for this Pastor’s Bible Study. With this study, we meet John Wesley again and discern the reason why Wesley is still relevant to us today. I highly recommend that we as Methodists take advantage of this opportunity to mature our faith and better to know John Wesley, who is the founder of the Methodist Church.

In the April Church Council meeting, it was decided that we target Sunday, May 30 for resuming in-person worship. During the other Sundays of May, we plan to have a parking lot service along with Facebook Live. Please let the church office know if you are interested in helping facilitate in-person worship. Our Easter joy will continue as we worship together on Sundays and study John Wesley through our Bible study!

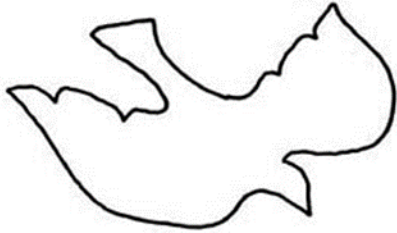
Alcoholics Anonymous Every Monday at 8:00 p.m.

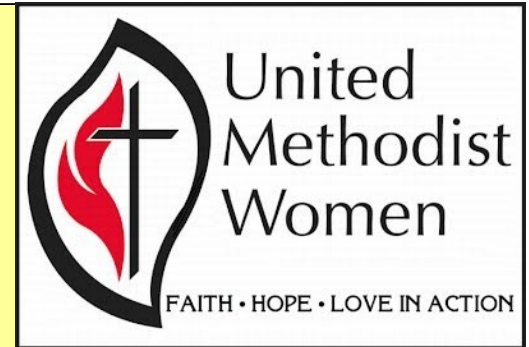

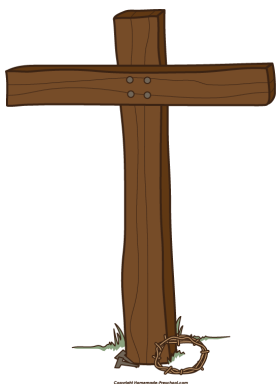
