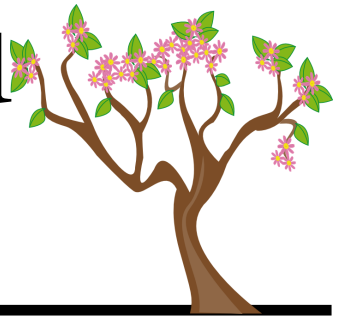

Greetings to The Family of Good Samaritan UMC

Bring peace to all of you from South Korea, I have arrived safely to Korea. I stayed at Gwanglim Prayer Mountain retreat center. They have eleven different statues of Jesus’ ministry and I visited each place to meditate and pray. I hope you also had a time alone with God.

I have visited a few places and one of them is DMZ (Demilitarized zone). Please pray for peace in South and North Korea, the war has been stopped for seventy year but war never ended. One of the things we did was to put prayer clothes on the fancying wire (see the picture below). People have visited this place and prayed for peace for past years. Praying for peace in the world is part of our faith journey with Jesus.

I don’t know when was the last time that I have worshiped in Korean church, and last week worship was soul touching for me. Of course, I have learned a few things. I pray that God will use our team to change the lives who come. I wish you also share God’s love to everyone you encounter.

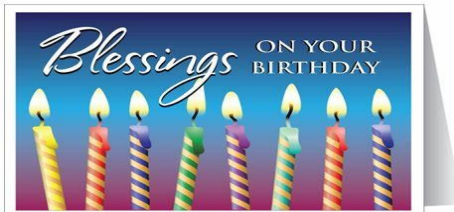

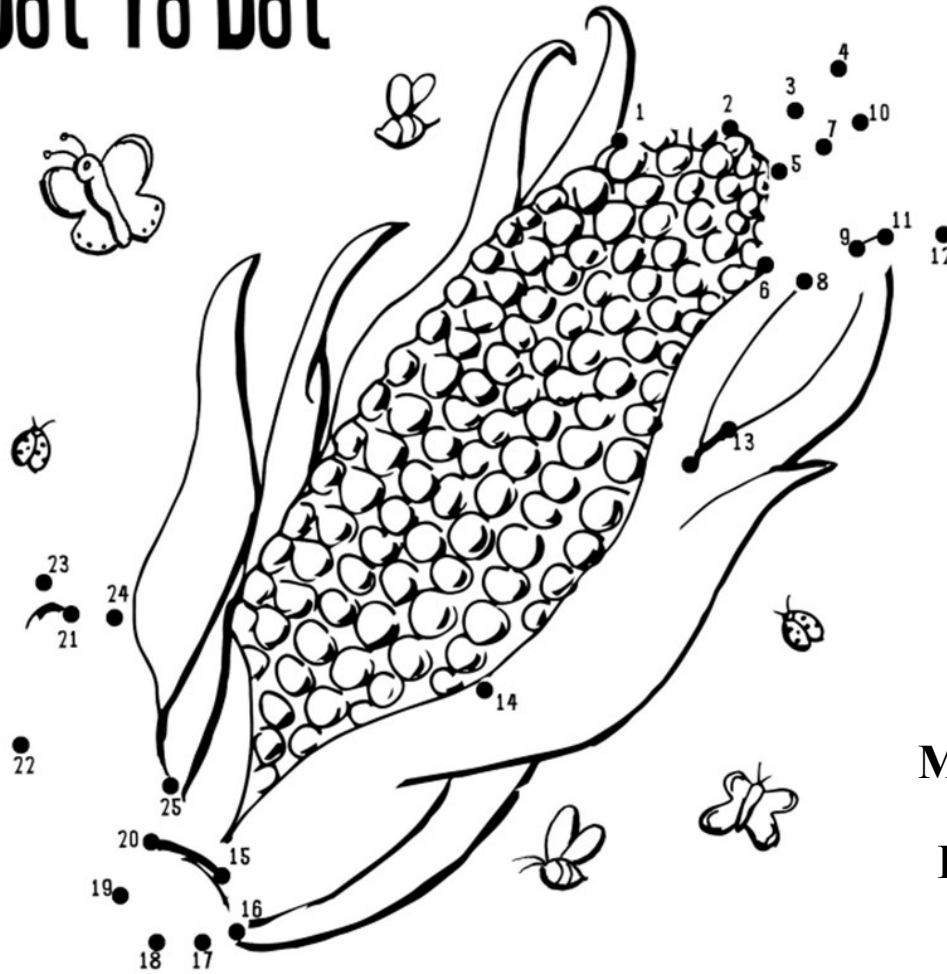

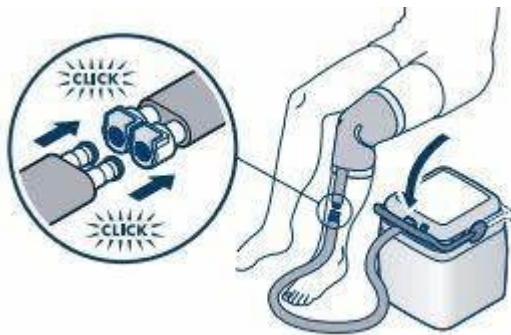

That could be soup, fruit, vegetables, meats, tuna. Also, if anyone has a garden and they are getting a surplus of vegetables and fruits please consider donating them to the food pantry. If you can't get the produce to the food pantry, just bring it to church and we will deliver it for you. There will be a basket out in the narthex. If it is more convenient for you, you can write a check made payable to Good Samaritan and in the memo line designate the Addison food pantry and we will then purchase the food and deliver it to the pantry.

The food pantry currently provides food and supplies for about 165 families. Because of the higher cost of living there will likely be an increase in the need for assistance.
