# From the Pastor

Dear families and friends of Good Samaritan UMC,

What excites you? What keeps you awake at night? I hope everything is well with your soul and your being. There are many things that we should be excited about and that keep us awake at night during June. Romans says, "Rejoice with those who rejoice and weep with those who weep." Romans 12:15.

We will celebrate with those who are graduating or advancing to the next level of education on June 4<sup>th</sup>. If the graduates are available to worship on that day, we will have time for blessing and celebration with them during the worship. If they cannot be here, we still want to recognize them by introducing them and praying over them.

As a United Methodist, June is the time for NIC Annual Conference to celebrate our ministries together. We will also celebrate with those who are commissioned and those who are being ordained on June 6<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. All are welcome. It will be held at Renaissance Schaumburg Convention Center Hotel. Every year during the NIC Annual Conference, we have mission challenges to fill the truck, and it will be delivered to Midwest Mission Distribution Center at 1001 Mission Drive, Pawnee, IL 62558. This year, the Bishop's Appeal focuses on Migrant Needs. The funds we raise together will go to organizations providing immediate needs like hygiene kits, temporary shelter, and food and longer-term needs like employment, housing, medical care, and legal assistance. Please pray for the NIC Annual Conference and consider donating to mission challenges or Bishops' Appeals to celebrate our ministries together.

June is also a time for us to celebrate Juneteenth. Do you know what Juneteenth is? Juneteenth celebrates the ending of slavery in the United States. President Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation on June 1, 1863. Although the Emancipation Proclamation was signed on June 1st, Juneteenth was celebrated on June 19th because it was on that very day Texas, the last state, agreed to end slavery. I visited the museum in Alabama during the Civil Rights Pilgrimage, and it was saddening to learn about the history of slavery in this country. It is an act of dehumanization, and it should never have happened. Yet, we see different kinds of enslavement and discrimination in our days. We rejoice with our African American brothers and sisters for freedom but also weep with those still facing discrimination. Also, don't forget about our fathers on Father's Day. Come to church with fathers and father figures to celebrate and worship with us.

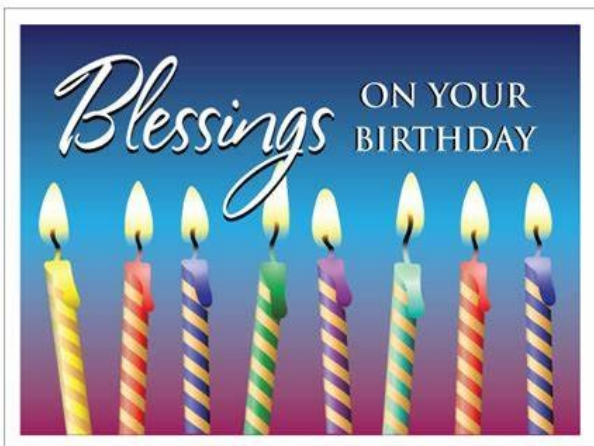

special offering, you can mail it into the church.**

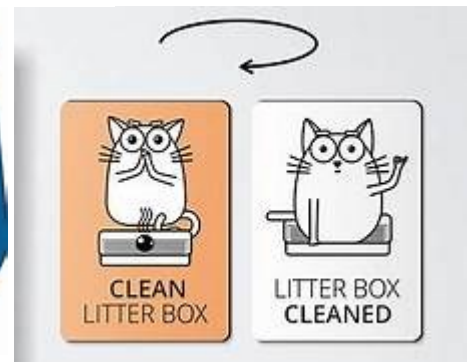
