# Trustee's Ministry

The next time you come to Good Samaritan, you may notice things look brighter than usual. Recently, the Board of Trustees entered into an agreement with an electrical contractor to upgrade the lighting throughout Good Samaritan, including the Montessori classrooms.

On March 15th & 17th electricians replaced 100% of our fluorescent tubes with brand new LED light strips. This conversion was done at **NO COST** to Good Samaritan!

The electrical contractor worked in conjunction with Commonwealth Edison, who is encouraging the transition to LED lighting. LED lights produce a brighter light, use less energy, produce less heat, and have a longer service life than previous lighting systems. Your Trustees will be monitoring future electrical bill to see what our electrical usage is and the savings we are realizing.


### **Sunrise Montessori Academy**






