Revelation 3:15-16 – "I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other!"


I am writing this article as we are in the middle of a heat wave. I imagine that by the time many of you read this it would have cooled down a little, but we know the summer months around here can be hot. So we do whatever it takes to cool us down. We crank up the air conditioning, grab cold drinks, and look for shade.

But spiritually, God doesn't want us cooling off. In fact, God longs for us to stay *hot*—burning with passion, commitment, and love. In Revelation 3, Jesus speaks to the church in Laodicea and warns them about being lukewarm—neither cold nor hot. He says He would rather they be one or the other, rather than spiritually indifferent. God isn't looking for half-hearted worship or occasional faith. He wants hearts on fire.

With this in mind I would like to share that The United Methodist recently revealed a new Guiding Vision Statement. 
